Career Services will provide services to students and alumni that specifically address the development of six **Career Competencies**:

- 1. Apply and articulate academic course content in a professional setting
- 2. Gain relevant experience that enhances the student's professional goals
- 3. Understand, develop, and articulate a "personal brand"
- 4. Develop a dynamic set of "professional documents" (resumes/CV, cover letter, LinkedIn profile, portfolio, etc.)
- 5. Engage in **professional development** by fostering a strong network of professionals and involvement in associations/industry groups
- 6. Successfully plan and execute a job search strategy that leads to employment

Students currently taking classes in a Degree or Certificate-seeking program

Career Advising:

- Only students enrolled in a degree/certificate program, have paid their tuition/fees, and have started classes are eligible for career advising
 - ColoradoSPH students at <u>Colorado State University</u> and <u>University of Northern Colorado</u> also have access to their respective campus career centers.
- CS staff will determine the appropriate amount of time and sessions, as well as format (individual, group, in-person, Skype, etc.) needed based on the individual studend needs.
- Students are expected to contact CS 24 hours in advance to change or cancel an appointment.

ColoradoSPH Alumni (1+ year after degree/certificate completion)

Eligibility:

- CS defines an "Alumnus" as
 - a former student who earned a degree or certificate from the Colorado School of Public Health at University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus, Colorado State University, or University of Northern Colorado

- o a former student who earned a degree/certificate from any defunct academic program that has since absorbed into the Colorado School of Public Health
- If a former ColoradoSPH student transferred to another school before earning a degree/certificate, **OR** took classes with ColoradoSPH but did not graduate, they **are not** considered an Alumnus
- ColoradoSPH Alumni can access all CS services for ONE YEAR after degree/certificate completion at the same level as a current ColoradoSPH student at no cost.

Career Advising (1 year+ after graduation):

- ColoradoSPH Alumni are eligible for three (3) additional one-hour career advising appointments per calendar year after the 1 year+ after graduation window. Additional sessions are charged at a rate of \$40 per session Payment is due at the beginning of the advising session.
- The amount of time, as well as format (in-person, phone, ZOOM online meeting), will be made by the Manager of Career & Employer Relations.
- Current ColoradoSPH students have first priority of scheduling career advising appointments.
- Alumni must contact the CS 24 hours in advance to change or cancel an appointment. A missed appointment without contacting CS will result in billing for the missed appointment.
