

History of the Colorado School of Public Health

The Colorado School of Public Health officially opened on July 1, 2008, following decades of dedicated development. Planning for this region's only school of public health involved a partnership of public health practitioners, academics, and business leaders. These leaders formed an official task force that proved instrumental in the decision to open the school as a collaboration between three of Colorado's leading universities: the University of Colorado, Colorado State University, and the University of Northern Colorado.

In 2008, as we prepared to officially open our doors, the Colorado public health community came together to also modernize Colorado's public health laws and ensure success in the future of Colorado's public health system. The Public Health Act of 2008 restructured Colorado's local public health and set the stage for required statewide assessment and planning, as well as the provision of a set of core public health services and standards. The Public Health Act of 2008 took effect on July 1, 2008—the same day the Colorado School of Public Health officially opened, creating a hub of innovative education and research, a foundation for the translation of scientific evidence into practice, and a new workforce development and training center in public health.

Today, ColoradoSPH has more than 700 students, 3,000 alumni, and 180 primary faculty across the three university campuses. Each day, the school's faculty, staff, students, and alumni find new and innovative ways to expand their work, build partnerships, and elevate public health.

Convocation Address and Keynote
*"Not Everything Bad Happens to Harm You:
Learning from Challenging Times "*

Patricia A. Gabow, MD, MACP
Professor Emerita, University of Colorado
Former President and CEO, Denver Health and Hospital Authority

Dr. Patricia A. Gabow is a national leader in delivery system innovation and the care of vulnerable populations. She spent her career at Denver Health and Hospital Authority, beginning as an academic practitioner and researcher in nephrology and spending the last 20 years there as the CEO, retiring in 2012.

The healthcare system that she revolutionized is an integration of the Denver Health Medical Center, a regional trauma center, the 911 system, a system of family health centers and clinics in public schools, the Rocky Mountain Poison and Drug Center, an inmate health care program, a public health institute, and more.

Dr. Gabow's advocacy work—from integrating the work of safety net hospitals with public health departments, to advocating for expanded insurance coverage through Medicaid and CHIP—aligns with the mission and vision of ColoradoSPH.

She is a professor emerita of medicine at the University of Colorado School of Medicine and a Master of the American College of Physicians.

Dr. Gabow has authored more than 170 articles and book chapters and three books, *The Lean Prescription: Powerful Medicine for Our Ailing Healthcare System*, *TIME'S NOW for Women Healthcare Leaders: A Guide for the Journey*, and most recently, *The Catholic Church and Its Hospitals: A Marriage Made in Heaven?*

She was a founding member of the federal Medicaid and CHIP Payment and Access Commission and currently serves as Chair of the Lown Institute Board.

Dr. Gabow is the recipient of numerous awards, including the National Academy of Medicine's Gustav O. Lienhard Award, the American Medical Association Nathan Davis Award for Outstanding Public Servant, the Association of American Medical Colleges David E. Rogers Award, the Florence Rena Sabin Award from the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus, and the Ohtli Award from the Mexican government.

She is a member of the Association for Manufacturing Excellence Hall of Fame, the National Academy of Social Insurance, and the Colorado Women's Hall of Fame. She is a graduate of Seton Hill University and the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania School. She is board certified in Internal Medicine and Nephrology.
